Members can receive electricity at about half the regular rate for loads controlled by one of Dakota Electric's Energy Wise off-peak programs.



## OFF-PEAK PROGRAMS

Energy Wise® off-peak programs allow members to get electricity from Dakota Electric at a reduced rate.

When demand for electricity is high, Dakota Electric must purchase wholesale power at higher prices in order to continue to supply reliable power to member homes and businesses. To reduce the need to purchase higher priced wholesale power, Dakota Electric offers members the opportunity to participate in "off-peak" programs. Participating members agree to let Dakota Electric interrupt power to certain electric loads when demand for electricity is high, and in return, receive reduced rates on the electricity used to power those loads.

### Qualifying off-peak loads:

#### Cooling

- Central air conditioners
- Air-source heat pumps
- Ground-source heat pumps

#### Water Heating

- Heat-pump water heaters
- Tank-style water heaters

#### Miscellaneous

- Swimming pool pumps
- Heat-pump pool heaters
- Hot tub heaters
- Electric vehicle chargers

#### Electric Heating\*

- Baseboard heaters
- Garage unit heaters
- In-floor heat coils
- Electric boilers
- Hard-wired space heaters
- Electric thermal storage space heaters
- Heat pumps

## Tips for choosing an electrical contractor:

1. Dakota Electric strongly encourages members to get at least three estimates for any project.
2. Plan ahead: For non-emergency work, contractors typically need two-to-three weeks from the date of estimating to completion of a job.
3. Member-supplied equipment, such as a vehicle charger, should be on site when the contractor arrives to do the work or additional charges may be assessed by the contractor.
