Manager of Safety Services Brandon Lunde presented a safety update and reviewed 2019, which was a very good year with only one recordable injury.

CEO Greg Miller presented his written report and highlighted the following items: community activities, Lebanon Hills substation rebuild update, locating damages report, vegetation management update, Advanced Metering Recovery fee was put into effect, website contact for board members, Burnsville franchise fee, and coronavirus precautions put in place.

Vice President of Information Services, CIO Mjyke Nelson provided an update on the advanced grid project.

Great River Energy directors Van De Bogart and Schreiner provided a written report and highlighted the following: regional meetings, rate projections, capital credits, and Coal Creek station update.
