

Board Summary February 25, 2021

The meeting was held by video conference due to COVID-19.

Board Chair Pittman provided a brief report of monthly activities, including attending the Great River Energy regional meeting and attending the audit committee meeting.

CEO Greg Miller presented his written report and highlighted the following along with reports from the Senior Management Team: Enterprise Resource Planning update, employee intranet site upgraded, cybersecurity update, regulatory filings, piloting two new EV rates, delinquent account update, fire inspection at office, reliability update, advanced meters providing reliability success stories, employee vaccine education, Touchstone Energy Community Award, fleet study assistance provided to Lakeville, and safety update.

Dr. Gabriel Chan, assistant professor at the University of Minnesota Humphrey School of Public Affairs in the Department of Center for Science, Technology and Environmental Policy shared a presentation regarding cooperatives navigating the energy transition and opportunities and challenges for distribution utilities.

CIO Mjyke Nelson presented an update on the AGi project, which is progressing well and under budget.

The board approved the purchase of switchgear for the Dodd Park substation.

Director Miller presented an updated from the Minnesota Rural Electric Association.

Director Sheldon provided an Audit Committee update.

The board approved two employee policies related to leave benefits and employee classifications/payroll practices.
